Homecoming Parade Guidelines:

All members of the Homecoming Court are to ride in the parade and have **candy to throw**.

Individuals, teams, clubs, etc are also encouraged to participate. The more we have, the better the parade will be. If you wish to participate in the parade, please sign up on the poster outside Mrs. Foster's room. **Students who ride in a vehicle with someone other than their parents or sibling MUST have a permission slip signed by parents. Permission slips are available in this packet. The last day to turn in parade forms will be Wednesday, October 11th.**

1. Parade participants are responsible for getting their own vehicle/float, etc.
2. Please bring several bags of candy to throw to the students along the parade route. BE VERY CAREFUL throwing the candy.
3. Parade vehicles should be here by 1:00 on Friday. They should be lined up in the parking lot behind the gym on the Asheville Highway side.

Homecoming Party guidelines:

The Homecoming party is only for current SCA high school students and their dates. Invited guest must also be high school students unless otherwise approved by administration. **All SCA students and their dates must turn in a signed form acknowledging the dress and date requirements in order to attend the party. These forms are available in Mrs. Foster's room.**

Any students bringing an outside date must turn in their date's information to Mrs. Foster by Wed. Oct. 11th.
