Math 7:

Our lessons this week continues as students learn prime factorization, identifying greatest common factors and least common multiple. A quiz on prime factorization, greatest common factor and least common multiple will be give Thursday, October 15, 2015.

Pre-Algebra:

Students will continue solving two-step equations, writing and solving verbal sentences for two step equations, using formulas to calculate distance, rate or time and calculating perimeter and area for rectangles. A test covering all concepts presented in Chapter 3 will be administered Thursday, October 15, 2015 for B day students and Friday, October 16, 2015 for A day students.

Honors Algebra I:

Students will begin chapter 3, Solving Linear Equations. Concept presented include translating and evaluating verbal sentences/equations, and using formulas to solve area for different geometric shapes.

7th & 8th Grade:

This week: We will complete Voc. Unit 4. Assignments will be made for Voc. Study in Unit 4.

We have checked out our first book for the AR reading grade. Students should be reading this book. They should spend **at least** fifteen minutes each night reading. They will take an AR Test when they have completed it. I told them their goal is to finish this book by mid-term (which will be Sept. 22). This way they would have time to read another book if they did not do as well as they hope to have on the first AR grade. **This AR grade is due no later than Oct. 15 for 7th grade and Oct. 14 for 8th grade.**

We have been working in the English book with Ch. 1 - Sentences. Students should be reviewing daily assignments and material covered. A test was administered on 9/30 for 8th grade. A test on Ch. 1 will be administered at the end of the chapter for 7th grade.

Eighth grade is beginning the novel *Journey to the Center of the Earth*. They will need to complete daily assignments and study material covered.

Students have Root cards that we are working on. Students will have a quiz on each set of five Root cards. Students should study each card every day. These roots will be an invaluable tool in their vocabulary study throughout high school and college. (Ask them about quizlet.com)
