8th Grade Bible

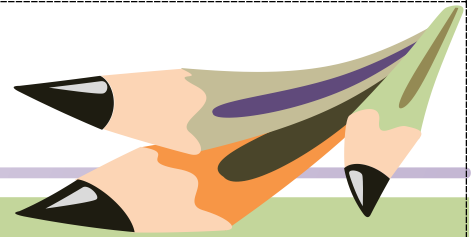
