Math with Ms. Johnson

Math 7:

Students will complete chapter 3, Applying Rational Numbers. Concepts will include multiplying and dividing fractions with mixed numbers and solving equations containing fractions. A chapter test covering concepts presented in Chapter 3, lessons 8-12 will be administered Monday, December 14. Students will also continue a review for their 2nd quarter nine weeks exam. The exam will cover material presented in chapter 2 and 3, and it will be given on Wednesday, December 16.

Pre-Algebra:

Students will conclude chapter 5, Rational Numbers and continue to review for 2nd Quarter nine-week exam. Chapter 5 test will be given on Friday, December 11, for "A" day pre-algebra students and Monday, December 14, for "B" day pre-algebra students. The exam will cover chapter 3-5 and will be given on Thursday, December 17 for "A" day pre-algebra students and Friday, December 18, for "B" day pre-algebra students.

Honors Algebra I:

Students will complete Chapter 5, Analyzing Linear Equations, and continue to review for the algebra mid-term exam. Concepts presented will include writing equations in slope-intercept form and geometry: parallel and perpendicular lines. Chapter 5 test will be given Monday, December 14. The exam will cover chapters 1-5 and will be given Friday, December 18.
