## Math with Ms. Johnson

### Math 7:

Students will review coordinate plane concepts and begin Chapter 4 at lesson 3. Concepts will include interpreting graphs and using functions tables to generate and graph ordered pairs.

### Pre-Algebra:

Students will begin chapter 6, Ratio, Proportion, and Percent. Concepts will include writing ratios as fractions in simplest form, determining unit rates, solving proportions, and using proportions to solve applicable problems. A proportion quiz will be given Friday, January 8 for B day students, and Monday, January 11 for A day students. Students are reminded to bring their calculators to each class meeting.

### Honors Algebra I:

Students will begin chapter 6, Solving Linear Inequalities. Concepts presented will include using addition, subtraction, multiplication and division to solve one step and multi-step inequalities.
