Students are working on compare/contrast writing. We will working on these during class and sharing.

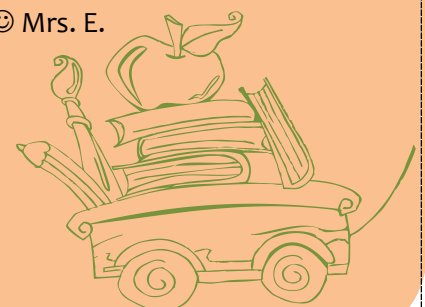
8th Honors – ELA

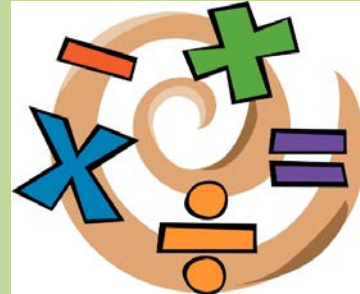
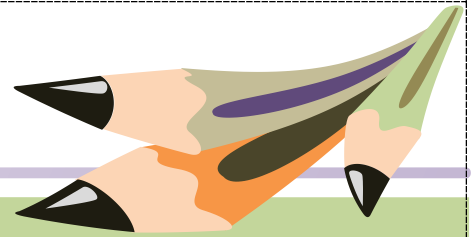
CHORUS
