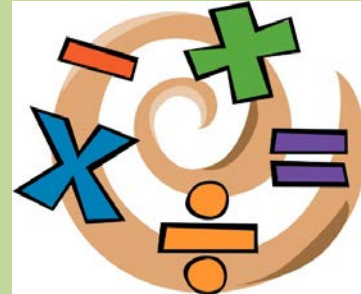
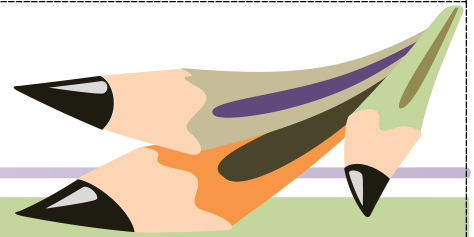
ART & CHORUS

MATH & SCIENCE

Math 7: Students will conclude their study of Geometric Figures. Concepts of area and perimeter of geometric shapes will be assessed on Thursday, May 12. We will begin our exam review the following week.

Pre-algebra: Students will complete chapter 10 selected lessons, Two Dimensional Figures. Concepts that will be assessed are line and angle relationships, area of irregular figures, perimeter, and circumference of circles. Test day is Thursday, May 12 for B day students and Friday, May 13 for A day students.
