GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Twenty-eight credits are required with the following specifications:

4 English	2 Foreign Language
4 Math	1 Physical Education/Health
4 Bible	1 Computer Science
3 Science	1 Composition and Research
3 Social Studies (U.S. History, Government/Economics, 1 elective)	5 Electives (1 elective in Fine Arts required)

Honors courses are available in the following subjects:

English, Math, Science, Foreign Language, Art, Chorus, Band and Theatre

Advanced Placement Courses offered:

AP Calculus, AP Statistics; AP US History; AP World History; AP English Literature and Composition; AP English Language and Composition, AP 2D Art and Design; AP Drawing

GRADING SYSTEM

GPA is computed according to the South Carolina Uniform Grading Scale.

A (90 - 100) = 4.000 – 6.000 quality points
B (80 - 89) = 3.000 – 4.900 quality points
C (70 – 79) = 2.000 – 3.900 quality points
D (60 – 69) = 1.000 – 2.900 quality points
F (0 – 59) = 0.100 – 1.900 quality points

All honors courses receive .5 extra quality points.

All dual credit and AP courses receive 1 extra quality point.

TEST SCORES
